1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council on 11th June 2019 made the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:

(a) relocate the residents' parking place on the north-west side of Wilfred Street, (outside No. 4) north-eastward by approximately 5.5 metres; and

(b) introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions:

(i) at the junctions of:

- Wilfred Street and Catherine Place;
- Catherine Place and Buckingham Place (extending to outside No. 6 Buckingham Place); and
- the northern and western arms of Catherine Place;

(ii) on the whole of the south-west side of Catherine Place; and

(iii) on the north-west side of Catherine Place (outside No. 23).
