An Abstratt of an Att passed in the last Seffions of Parliament for Granting certain Inland Duties upon Coffee, Tea, and Chocolate.

Notice is hereby given, That all Offices of Excile in London, and all other Offices of Excile throughout the United Kingdom of Great Britain, are conflituted Offices for the faid Inland Duties on Coffee, Tea, Cocoa-Nuts and Chocolate; and that by an A& paffed the now laft Seffions of Parliament, it is amongft other things enacted, ',

That Chocolate ready made, or Cocoa Paste, if imported, after the 24th of June 1924, fhall be forfeited with the double Value thereof, and the Bags, Casks, and other Fackage containing the fame

That after the each of June 1921, there must be paid the Inland Duties following, viz. for Coffee a s. per Pound and proportionably; for Tea 4.5. per Pound and proportionably; for Chocolare 1 s. 6 d. per Round and proportionably. That every Druggif, Graces, Chandler, Cof-

fee-house-keeper, Chocolate-house-keeper, and ex very other Seller of or Dealer in Coffee, Tea, or Cocoa-Nuts, or any of them, and every Maker or Seller of Chocolate either by Wholefale or Re-tale, who on or before the 24th Day of June 1724, doth not at the next Office for the faid Inland Duties make a true Entry in Writing of ever ry Warehoufe, Storehoufe, Room, Shop, Cellar, Yault, and other Place and Places by each of them refpectively used for keeping Coffee, Tea, Cocoa-Nuts or Chocolate, or for making Chocolate, and allo of all the Coffee, Tea, Cocoa-Nuts and Cho-colate, which at the Time of fuch refpective Encolate, which at the Time of Iuch respective En-tries shall be in fuch their Warehouses, Storehoufes, Rooms, Shops, Cellars, Vaults, and other Places, and every of them respectively, shall forfait 200 I. for every fuch Warehouse, Storehouse, Room, Shop, Cellar, Vault and other Place, which after the faid 24th of June 1724 fhall be formade use of without being for entered, and also all the Coffee, Tea, Cocca-Nuts and Chocolate which thall be found therein, and also the Canifters, Bags, Are Tube, Bourge Cather and other Volfela and Jars, Tubs, Boxes, Casks and other Veilels and Package whatfoever containing the fame.

That every one who after the faid 24th of June 1724, shall become a Druggist, Grocer, Chandler, Coffee-houfe-keeper, Chocolate-houfe-keeper, and every Seller of or Dealer in Coffee, Tea, Cocoa-Núts or Chocolate, either by Wholefale or Re-tale, or Maker of Chocolate, who before taking into his, her or their Cuftody any Coffee, Tea-Cocoa-Nuts or Chocolate, doth not at the next Office for the faid Inland Duties, make the like true Entry in Writing of every Warehoufe, Storehoufe, Room, Shop, Cellar, Vault and other Place intended after the faid 24th of June 1724 to be made use of for the keeping of Coffee, Tea, Corcoa-Nuts or Chocolate, or for the making Chocolate, shall for every such Place forfeit 200 l. and all the Coffee, Tea. Cocoa-Nuts and Chocolate found therein, and alfo all the Caniflers, Bags, Jars, Tubs, Boxes, Casks and other Veffels or Package

whatloever containing the fame. That after the 24th of June 1724, no Coffee, Tea, Cocoa-Nuts or Chocolate, fhall be brought into fach. Warehoufe, Storehoufe, Room, Shop, Cellar, Vaule or other Place fo made ufe of by any Druggift, Grocer, Chandler, Coffee-houfe-keeper, Chocolate-houfe-keeper, without first gia-ving Notice thereof to the Officer of the faid Inland Duties; of the Division or Place where fuch Coffee, Tea, Cocoa-Nuts or Chocolate are intended to be lodged, and producing to and leaving with the faid Officer, an Authentick Cer-tificate figned by the Officer for the faid Inland Daties from whence fuch Coffee, Tea, Cocea-Nuts or Chocolate thall be brought, that, in cafe of Coffee, Tea or Chocolate, the Inland Duties charged on fuch Coffee, Tea or Chocolate fo in-tended to be brought thither, have been actu-ally psid, or that the fame have been condemned as forfeited, or was Part of the Stock in Hand of into fuch. Warehoufe, Storehoufe, Room; Shop, as forfeited, or was Part of the Stock in Hand of fome Druggift, Grocer, Chandler, Coffee-houfe-keeper, or Chocolate-houfe-keeper, or other Seller of or Dealer in Coffee, Tea, or Chocolate, or making of Chocolate. And in cafe of bringing in Cocoa-Nuts, That the fame have been duly entered with the Officer or Officers of His Majefty's Cuftoms, or that they were condemned as forfeited, or were Part of the Stock in Hand of fome Druggift or other Person selling or dealing therein, upon or before the faid 24th of June 1724, of which anAccount had been taken on or before the faid 24th of June 1724, expressing the Quantity and Quality thereof, and at what Place the faid Inland Duties were fo paid, or what Port or Place the Cuftoms and Duties were to paid, or the faid Coffee, Tea, Cocoa Nuts or Chocolate were condemned, or of whole Stock in Hand the fame were Part, on Pain of Forfeiting the Coffee, Tea, Gocoa-Nuts or Chocolate to brought in, without fuch Notice or Certificate; and treble the Value thereof, together, with the Canifters, Bags, Jars, Boxes, Casks and other Veffels or Package what loever containing the fame.
