On_the 28th past Mr. Stanhope, the British Ambassadour, had an Au-dience of the Catholick King at Aranjuez, when he presented two Letters from His Britannick Majefty; one being in Anfwer to a Letter King Lewis wrote to notify to His Majefty his Acceffi-on to the Crown, and the other being new Cre-dentials for his Excellency Mr. Stanhope, who returned hither from Aranjuez the 29th. Some Days ago his Catholick Majefly ordered the Duke of Fernandina, a Grandee of Spain of the first Rank, to leave Madrid in 24 Hours and to repair to Pampelona, for threatning the Superintendant-General of the Revenues, who refused the Duke fome Satisfaction for an Affront offered to him by the Officers of the Cuftoms who flopped his Coach as it was entring the Gates of Madrid at Night, and fearched it for Contraband Goods but found none; the faid Duke fet out accordingly for Pampelona, all Intercessions with the King by feveral Grandees of Spain of the first Rank for revoking the faid Order, having been in vain Don Geronimo Solis, a Son of the Dutchefs of Monteleano, Camarera Mayor or first Lady of the Bed Chamber to King Lewis's Queen, is appointed Governour of Malaga.

Turin, June 10. N. S.
