Madrid, July 17, N. S.

**O**N the 13th Instant the Marshal de Tessé went to St. Ildefonso, to introduce the Abbot de Livry to King Philip and his Consort: They are expected to return hither the 19th, after which the said Abbot will immediately proceed on his Embassy to the Court of Portugal. King Lewis has granted to Don Ferrante Pignatelli, an Exempt in his Majesty's Life-Guards, a Pension of 1000 Pistoles a Year. Letters from Cadix of the 10th Instant advise, that the two Men of War which are to carry the Quick-silver to the West-Indies, were then under Sail.

Chantilly, July 28, N. S. The 1st of next Month the King sets out from hence on his Return to Versailles. The 26th Instant the Duke of Orleans came again to wait on the King, and having dined with his Majesty went back that Afternoon to Bagnolet. The same Day the Cardinal de Bissy arrived here from Rome, and was introduced to the King by the Bishop of Frejus. The 27th that Cardinal had a long Conference with the Duke of Bourbon. During his Majesty's Stay here a Declaration for clearing the Kingdom of Beggars and Vagabonds, by certain Regulations for employing those who are able to work, and for maintaining the rest in Hospitals, has been sent to the Parliament of Paris, who having registered it, the same will be forthwith put in Execution.

And for preventing as much as possible any Abuses in the said Payments, it will be expected, that where the Seamen cannot attend themselves, their Letters of Attorney shall be witnessed by two or more Commission or Warrant Officers of His Majesty's Ships in which they serve, or by two or more of the Officers of His Majesty's Navy or Victualling, or by the Mayor, or by two or more of the Magistrates of some Corporation, or by a Publick Notary, or by the Minister and Church-Wardens of the Parish, (where the other cannot be had,) and where old Letters of Attorney are produced, they are to be accompanied with the like Attestation that the Persons who made the same are living.
