N the 13th Inftant the Marshal de Teffé went to St. Ildefoulo, to intro-duce the Abbot de Livry to King Philip and his Confort: They are expected to return bither the 19th, after which the faid Abbot will immediately proceed on his Em-baffy to the Court of Portugal. King Lewis has granted to Don Ferrante Pignatelli, an Exempt in his Majefty's Life-Guards, a Peo fion of 1000 Pistoles a Year. Letters from Gadiz of the 10th Inftant advise, that the two Men of War which 'are to carry the Quick-filver to the Weff Indies, were then under Sail.

Chantilly, July 28, N.S. The 1st of next Month the King fets out from bence on his Return to Verfailles. The 26th Instant the Duke of Orleans came again to wait on the King, and having dined with his Majefty went back that Afternoon to Bagnolet. The fame Day the Cardinal de Biffy arrived here from Rome, and was introduced to the King by the Bishop of Frejus. The 27th that Cardinal had a long Conference with the Duke of Bourbon. During his Majefty's Stay here a Declaration for clearing the Kingdom of Beggars and Vagsbonds, by certain Regulations for employing those who are able to work, and for maintaining the reft in Hospitals, has been fent to the Parliament of Paris, who having registred it, the fame will be forthwith put in Execution.
