SECTION 15 OPEN SPACES ACT 1906

SECTION 236 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972

NOTICE is hereby given that Islington London Borough Council has made byelaws regulating the use of barbecues on Highbury Fields under section 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 and that, in accordance with section 236 of the Local Government Act 1972, it intends to apply to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government for confirmation of those byelaws.

Application for confirmation of the byelaws will be made on or shortly after 21st February 2020. The byelaws will not come into effect unless and until they are confirmed by the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State may confirm or refuse to confirm the byelaws submitted for confirmation, and may fix the date on which the byelaws are to come into operation. If no date is so fixed, the byelaws shall come into operation at the expiration of one month from the date of their confirmation.

Copies of the byelaws have been placed on deposit at the offices of the Council at the Waste Reuse and Recycling Centre, 1 Cottage Road, N7 8TP and at the Town Hall, Upper Street, London N1 2UD and may be inspected without payment on any weekday during usual business hours for one month from the date of publication of this notice.
