Stockholm, August 19, O. S.

ON the 10th Instant the King of Sweden went to take the Diversion of Hunting four or five Leagues beyond Upsal, when it was said he designed to return hither the 15th, but his Majesty is since gone on Northwards towards Gasse, and will probably not be back before the 24th Instant. The same Day the King set out for Upsal, the Queen went from Carlberg to Drotningholm, another Palace about two Leagues from hence, and the 17th in the Evening her Majesty returned to the Palace here in Town. It has been pretty much talk'd here all this Month, that the Landgrave of Hesse-Cassel, his Swedish Majesty's Father, was desirous to come over and pay a Visit to his Son at Stockholm, and there are Letters by the last Post from Cassel, which make the Journey very probable; it is certain, that the Dutchess Dowager of Mecklenburg, his Swedish Majesty's Sister, has laid aside her Design of coming over hither this Year. Two Days ago was published here an Ordinance Enacted at the last Meeting of the States, by the Title of a Diet Ordinance, consisting of 25 Articles; by which both the Manner of Proceeding at all future Diets is established, and also the Methods that are to be observed upon the Election of a new King, whenever the Swedish Throne becomes vacant by the Demise of their present Majesties. Last Monday arrived two Mails from Finland with Letters from Petersbourg of the 7th Instant, O. S. which say the Ratifications of the late Treaty between the Czar and the Turke was arrived there from Constantinople some Days before. The last Letters from Schonen brought an Account, that Lieutenant-General

Ranck was arrived at Malmoe from Hambourg, and he is expected here this Week.

Copenhagen, Aug. 29, N. S. The Court continues at Fredericksbourg, and 'tis thought will stay there all Summer. M. Buys has had several Conferences with the Ministers here about the Payment of the Troops employed in the late War. The two Princes of Saxe-Gotha are lodged at Fredericksbourg and have a Table every Night, at the King's Expence: They dine every Day with his Majesty, and are attended by his Coaches when they go Abroad.

Copenhagen, Sept. 5, N. S. The two Princes of Saxe-Gotha, having taken Leave of the Court, are returned hither; whence they intend to go to Wimbletoft the Country Seat of Prince Charles and Princess Sophia, and from thence to Hambourg.

Berlin, Sept. 2, N. S. The 29th of last Month, the King went from Potsdam to Wolterhausen early in the Morning; the Queen with the Princess Royal left this Town the same Day in the Afternoon, to go to Wolterhausen; and 'tis said the Court will continue there six Weeks.

Windsor, September 7.

On the 5th Instant the King dined at the Earl of Orkney's at Clevedon, about seven Miles from hence, attended by divers of the Nobility and Gentry. At His Return hither in the Evening, this Town was all illuminated, and he was received here with loud Acclamations of Joy; as He had been in the several Villages through which He passed.

On the 5th Instant came Advice, that King Lewis of Spain died the Night between the 30th and 31st of last Month, N. S.
