- (l) In relation to vehicles being used for the following purposes and only if that vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other length of road or at any other time and provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such duties for that vehicle to proceed in any prescribed street: -
- (a) for the removal of any obstruction to traffic
- (b) In connection with building, excavation or demolition operations.

# Power to Modify or Suspend this Order

5. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Council's Head of Highways, or some person authorised by him, may, if it appears to him or that other person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement or traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend any provision of this Order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council, in connection with the provision of controlled parking zone in the Warple Way area, propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
- 2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to:
- (a) introduce "shared use permit holder /telephone" parking places for the use of residents, their visitors and business users in lengths of Bradford Road, Canham Road, Stanley Gardens and Warple Way;
- (b) provide that the parking places would operate between the hours of 9am and 7pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (c) provide that passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles, motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles may be left in a parking place without limitation on time during the controlled hours and provided that with the exception of motorcycles and disabled persons vehicles, a valid (in an electronic form) SG zone permit or voucher has been issued to the vehicle or payment made by mobile phone using the telephone payment parking system operated by Pay by Phone whilst parked in the parking place;

(d) provide that the charges for parking in the "shared use/telephone" parking places would be £2 per hour up to a maximum stay of 5 hours. No return would be permitted to the parking place for 2 hours; (e) Users of the telephone payment system should follow the instructions displayed in the parking place quoting the unique number relating to that parking place to the service provider and providing information as requested. Payment of the parking charge can then be made using most debit and credit cards. Text receipt for the parking session and expiry of parking reminder text messages are available free of charge.

- 3. The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Order would be to amend existing waiting restrictions or introduce new waiting restrictions that would apply "at any time" at road junctions, or between the controlled hours of 9am and 7pm on Mondays to Saturdays in lengths of Bradford Road, Canham Road, Stanley Gardens and Warple Way.
- 4. The general effect of the Loading Place Order would be to revise the definition of the loading places in Warple Way.
- 5. Business Parking Permits would be available at a cost of £800 per annum.
- 6. Residents' Parking Permits (which are issued in an electronic form) would be charged as follows
