HE Foreign Miniflers, who went to St. Ildefonfo to pay their Compliments of Condoleance to his Catholick Majefly opon the Death of the late King Lewis of Spain, 28 likewife their Compliments upon bis present Majesty's Re-accession to the Crown, are returned bither from thence. Their Ca-tholick Majesties with the lofantes will be here on the 28th Inftant, in ordet to be prefent at the Sitting of the Cortes, which are to be held the Beginning of the next Month for Executing the Acts neceffary to recognize the Infante Don Ferdinand Prince of Afturias. His Catholick Majefty has been pleafed to continue Don Juan Baptifta Orendayn Secretary of State, and he is to ferve his Majefty in that Employment in Cale of the Illnefs or Absence of the Marquels de Grimaldo. The Marquels de Lede is made Prefident of the Council of War in the Room of the Marquels de Aytona, who has obtained Leave of his Majefty to refign the faid Employment, and to retire into the Country. The King of Spain has granted the pro-per Cedulas for the Admiffion of the South-Sea Company's Annual Ship (which is to fail this Year) into the Spanish Wett Indies. Letters from Cadiz advife, that a Spanish Ship is lately arrived at that Port from the Honduras, having on Board One Million Two Hundred Thouland Pieces of Eight.
