Madrid, Off.30. This Day their Catholick Majestice arrived here at the Palace from St. Ildefonso: Their Majestice stopped upon the Road at a Place called Campillo, and diverted themselves with hunting of Stage and wild Boars; of which they killed several. The Sitting of the Cortes is put off till the 25th of pext Month, on account of many Bishops who can-not be here sooner.
