Petty Officer Engineering Technician (Marine Engineering Submarines) Jonathon Wayne NORFOLK, Royal Navy, 30027161.

For demonstrating incredible selflessness, bravery and resilience in entering a flooded Forward Engine Room Bilge and manually operating valves to stop water draining out of the ruptured Ballast System, and then beginning the process of pumping the flood water out of the submarine, aboard HMS TALENT on 2nd December 2020.

Colour Sergeant Bishwahang RAI, The Royal Gurkha Rifles, 21170464.

For an exceptional act of bravery in coordinating the extraction of his Company deep in the jungle at night, during a tropical thunderstorm in which a bolt of lightning rendered seven unconscious, leaving a further 20 in excruciating pain and unable to move, in Brunei Darussalam on 25th – 26th August 2020.

Corporal Dean Jonathan WILSON, The Royal Logistic Corps, Army Reserve, 24899533.

For his selfless bravery in deliberately putting himself at risk to save the life of a vulnerable child who had been cut off by the incoming tide and was stranded on a tree trunk in an estuary. He remained in danger, in the cold water and fading light, until the child could be rescued, in Carmarthen on 25th November 2019.
