N the 1st Instant his Swedish Majesty went out a hunting, being attended by his Excellency Count Horn, Prefident of the Chancery, at whole Country-Seat in Rolla-He chances, at how to be the point of the King has taken up his Quarters. The Squadron appointed for this Year's Service in the Mediterranean, being now in Readinefs, M. Somerdyck who commands it, fets out from hence the 2d of next Month, in order to go on board and put to Sea from the Texel.
