To recommend it to all Persons who shill hereafter bave occasion to send any Bank Notes in their Letters, to write upon the Ba k-side of every Note the Name of the Post-Town where they put in their Letters, with the Day of the Month at Length, and not in Figures, when they are put in; and also the Addition of these Words, viz. Per Post to---- naming the Town to which they are sent.

As for Example; If from London to Chester, the Endorsement will be as follows, viz.

London, March the third, 1724. Per Post to Chester;

So from Chester to any Town in the Neighbouring Countries, or to any Town in a remote Country, when the Letter is to pass through London; as from Chester to
