NORTHUMBERLAND PLACE (PLAY STREET)

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council proposes to make the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- The City of Westminster (Parking Places) (B Zone) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*;
- \bullet The City of Westminster (Prescribed Routes) (No. *) Traffic Order 202*; and
- The City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be, in connection with the making permanent of the temporary Play Street introduced in Northumberland Place in April 2019, to:
- (a) prohibit vehicles from Northumberland Place between 3.00 p.m. and sunset on Mondays to Fridays and between 10.00 a.m. and sunset on Saturdays and Sundays, only between April and September, except for access;
- (b) introduce one-way working southbound in Northumberland Place;
- (c) extend the double yellow line "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions on the east side of Northumberland Place, adjacent to No. 47 Talbot Road, southward by 7 metres, replacing one pay-by-phone parking bay; and
- (d) introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions at the junction of Northumberland Place with Artesian Road (for a total of 24.5 metres).

- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be to introduce a loading bay (14.7 metres in length) on the west side of Aldwych, outside the One Aldwych Hoperate "at any time" with a maximum stay of 30 minutes and no return within 1 hour.

BLACK BOY LANE, CONWAY ROAD AND ETHERLEY ROAD N15 - SAFETY MEASURES FOR CHESTNUTS PRIMARY SCHOOL THE HARINGEY (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (NO.1) ORDER 2022 THE HARINGEY (FREE PARKING PLACES, LOADING PLACES AND WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT NO.26) ORDER 2022 T65

- 1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey on 6th May 2022 has made the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders will be to introduce:-School Street Zone SS01 - Chestnuts Primary School
- (a) Timed pedestrian and cycle zones in which motor vehicles, except for those issued a permit would be prohibited from entering, Mon-Fri 8 a.m. and 9.15 a.m. and between 2:30 p.m. and 3.45 p.m. during school term times, between the prescribed hours below and when the appropriate signs are on display on the following road:

Etherley Road N15, between its junctions with Black Boy Lane and Conway Road

Those eligible for permits include properties and residents of 76-82 Etherley Road (evens), 81-87 Etherley Road (odds), 119-121 Black Boy Lane (odds), qualified medical practitioners attending to provide critical care to residents within the prescribed zone, disabled badge holders who requires access to a property within the prescribed zone and school buses and vehicles used in the transport of children and adults with special access needs in relation to Chestnuts Primary School within the zone. All vehicles will be allowed to exit the zone whilst it is in operation.

- (b) loading restrictions operating at any time, in:-
- i. Conway Road, on both sides, at its junction of Etherley Road;
- ii. Etherley Road, on the west side, at its junction with Conway Road;
- iii. Etherley Road, on both sides, at its junction with Black Boy Lane;
- $\hbox{iv. Black Boy Lane, on both sides, at its junction with Etherley Road;}\\$
- (c) waiting restrictions operating at any time in Black Boy Lane, on the east side, opposite its junction with Etherley Road;

NOTES: These Orders supersedes similar provisions at the above locations implemented by way of experimental Orders made under section 9 of the 1984 Act (which are revoked).

- 3. Date of operation: The Order will come into operation on 16th May 2022.
