P R E S E N T,

Their Excellencies the Lords Justices in Council.

It was this Day ordered by their Excellencies the Lords Justices in Council, that the Parliament which stands prorogued to Thursday the 1st of July next, should be further prorogued to Thursday the 12th Day of August following

His Majesty having been pleased by Letters Patents under the Great Seal of Great Britain, to constitute his Grace Charles Duke of Bolton Constable of His Majesty's Tower of London, and also Lord Lieutenant of the Tower-Hamlets: His Grace this Day in Council took the Oaths appointed to be taken instead of the Oaths of Allegiance and Supremacy as Constable of the said Tower, and as Lord Lieutenant of the said Tower-Hamlets; and likewise the Oath of Constable of the Tower of London.

Lisbon, June 3, N. S. On the 28th past Sen. d'Acunha Brochado set out from hence for the Court of Spain. The Dutch Squadron appointed to cruize this Summer in the Mediterranean, against the Algerines, failed out of this River for Cadiz on the 28th past. The Portuguese Man of War of 40 Guns, called the *Rofario*, failed this Morning for the Rio de Janeiro, having four Merchant Ships under her Convoy.

Madrid, June 11, N. S. On the 8th Instant in the Morning their Catholick Majesties went from hence to St. Ildefonso. The Marquess de Grimaldo Counsellour and Secretary of State attended his Catholick Majesty thither, and this Day the Marquess de Castelar Secretary at War set out for the same Place. The Marquess de la Paz Secretary for the Finances, who had been also named to attend his Catholick Majesty thither, was taken ill of a Fever, which obliges him to remain here till he is recovered. Two Days since arrived here Sig. de Brochado as Minister from the King of Portugal.

Hanover, June 26, N. S. The 23d Instant at Night, the King arrived at Osnabrug. His Majesty staid there the 24th with his Royal Highness the Duke of York; and last Night His Majesty arrived at Herrenhausen. His Majesty and his Royal Highness Prince Frederick are (God be thanked) in perfect Health.
