The Trustee was previously notified of the Member's death in 2018, and since then the Trustee has corresponded with all known contacts of the Member as well as the Official Solicitor and Public Trustee to identify one or more beneficiaries who qualify for payment of a discretionary death benefit in respect of the Member. Such beneficiary must be one of the following:

- 1. the spouse;

- 4. any spouse (whether or not remarried or having entered into a subsequent civil partnership) of any of the persons described in 2 or 3 above:
- 5. the parents of the Member and the parents of the spouse;
- 6. any person to whose advancement, maintenance or support the Member shall in the opinion of the Trustee have contributed;
- 7. any person beneficially interested under any testamentary disposition of the Member;
- 8. any person nominated by the Member as a beneficiary; or
- 9. the Member's executors or legal personal representatives.

Adopted persons and step children shall be treated as the children of their adopters and step parents.

To date, no such individual has been identified: if no prospective beneficiary can be identified **within two months** of the date of publication of this notice, the funds will distributed as otherwise permitted by the Scheme rules and trust law. Accordingly, it is of vital importance that any person having a prospective claim and who has not received correspondence from the Trustee should make themselves known to the Trustee.
