BURIAL ACT 1853

Notice is hereby given that representations have been made to His Majesty in Council by the Secretary of State for Justice that, subject to the exceptions listed below, burials should be discontinued in the following places of burial and that His Majesty in Council was pleased on 8th March 2023 to order that such representations be taken into account by a Committee of the Privy Council on 19th April 2023.

- 1) St Bartholomew's Churchyard Extension, Keelby, Lincolnshire;
- 2) St James Churchyard, Badsey, Worcestershire.

The exceptions are that:-

- a) in the place numbered 2 above, in any vault or walled grave in the churchyard, burial may be allowed but every coffin in such vault or grave must be separately enclosed by stonework or brick work properly cemented;
- b) in places numbered 1 and 2 above, in any existing earthen grave in the churchyard, the burial may be allowed of the body of any member of the family of the person or persons previously buried in that grave, but no part of the coffin containing the body shall be less than one metre below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave. His Majesty in Council is pleased to give Notice of these representations and to order that they be taken into consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council on 19th April 2023. (4297718)
