1) St Bartholomew's Churchyard Extension, Keelby, Lincolnshire;

2) St James Churchyard, Badsey, Worcestershire.

The exceptions are that:-

a) in the place numbered 2 above, in any vault or walled grave in the churchyard, burial may be allowed but every coffin in such vault or grave must be separately enclosed by stonework or brick work properly cemented;

b) in places numbered 1 and 2 above, in any existing earthen grave in the churchyard, the burial may be allowed of the body of any member of the family of the person or persons previously buried in that grave, but no part of the coffin containing the body shall be less than one metre below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave.
