- iv) Thursday 6am to 7pm, no overnight parking
- v) Sunday overnight parking only 7pm to 6am Monday

NB. Access will be permitted to permit holders only (M1) within the affected pedestrian and cycle zone.

PARKING CHANGES AND INTRODUCTION OF A MOTORCYCLE PERMIT
THE ISLINGTON (CHARGED-FOR PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 2023
THE ISLINGTON (FREE PARKING PLACES, LOADING PLACES AND WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 2023**

1) NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Islington proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling.

2) The general effect of the Orders would be to:

- a) introduce a dedicated disabled bay o/s No. 21 St George's Avenue;
- b) remove the resident permit parking place on Baring Street (north-west side) immediately north-east of the junction with New North Road and replace with 'at any time' waiting restrictions;
- c) relocate the existing dedicated disabled bay o/s 2a Cleveland Rd (DB020) south-westward by 2.8 metres, existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions north of the disabled bay will be extended and the existing resident permit parking place south of the disabled bay will be shortened by 2.8 metres;
- d) convert 10 metres of the existing pay by phone parking place opposite No. 74 Prebend Street to a business permit parking place;
- e) shorten the existing parking bay o/s 63 Wall Street to a length of 5 metres and shift slightly northwards towards the junction with Dove Road;
- f) make the existing waiting restrictions outside 35 Wedmore Street enforceable 'at any time';
- g) make the existing waiting restrictions outside 9 Charlton Place enforceable 'at any time';
- h) make a 7.8 metres section of the existing waiting restriction outside 1 & 3 Napier Terrace enforceable 'at any time';
- i) make minor amendments to the map schedules so that they accurately reflect the on-street parking layout. These amendments will not result in changes on-street;
- j) introduce a motorcycle permit. Motorcycle permit holders will not need to pay the £1 daily charge for parking in solo motor cycle bays, the charge for this permit will be:
 - i) £61.20 a year or £30.60 for electric motorcycles for residents;
 - ii) For non-residents:
