The purpose of the proposed revisions are to make provision for the management of the College's endowment on a total return basis, including updating matters of day-to-day administration, providing for two Vice-Masters to serve concurrently, and clarifying certain matters connected with charity registration, for example, the status of student members of Council as charity trustees.
