Lisbon, March 9, N. S.

ON the 12th paft Vice-Admiral Sommelf. dyck entred this Port with shree Dutch Men of War, from cruifing in the Streights. His Britannick Majefty's Ship the Durfley Galley is now in this Porr, but is to fail very fhortly for the Mediterranean. His Portuguefe Majefty fet out from hence for Salvaterra the 24 th of laft Month, and having taken the Di verfion of Hunting there fome Days, returned hither on the 2d Inftant in the Evening: His Majefty, according to Cuffom, was pleated to fend Prefents of the Game he had killed in Hunting to the Foreign Minifters refiding at this Courr.
Madrid, Marcb II, N. S. On the sth Infant, the King and Queen of Spain came from the Pardo to the Buen-Retiro, where they will flay till her Majefty is ready to lye in, which is expected in the Month of May, and then they will come so the Palace here. On the 8th Inflant, the Marquefs de Campo-Florido died, in the both Year of his Age : He was for feveral Years Prefident of the Council of Finances, and Superintendant General of the Revenues of this Kingdom: He began his Fortune by being a Farmer of fome of his Catholick Majefty's Revenues, and was made a Marquefs in Confideration of having advanced a confiderable Sum of Money to the Crown apon an urgent Occafion in the lare War: He has jett a Million and a half of Pieces of Eight to his Son and Daughter. The Duke of Ripperda, the prefent Superintendant-General of the Finances, has ordered fria Enquiry to be made into the Management of all Adminiftrators and Colle Etors of Duties and Revenues : He has alfo difmiffed a great many Bailiffs of the Courr, and reduced the Number of them to One Hundred. Yefterday the Three Hundred Horfe-Guards which were fent laft Year into Catalonia, arrived here. Letters from Barcelona of the ad Inflant advife, that the ten Battallions lately ordered from thence, fome to Arragon and forme to Valencia,
were on their March thither. They write from St. Andero the 2 sth paft, that the three Mufoovite Ships which were at Cadiz laft Year, and in their Return from thence put into St.Andero, continued in that Harbour, waiting for better Weather in order to continue their Voyage to the Beltick. We have an Account from Cadiz of the sth Inftant, that they had Advise there, that the Capitana, one of the biggeft Ships of the Flota which failed laft Year from thence for Vera.Cruz, was blown up in the Paffage, and that of 800 Men on board her only 300 were faved; that (if this Advice be confirmed) this is the sth principal Ship of the Spanifh Fleet which bave perifhed within thefe two Years; and that of thofe which are leff, the two Men of War built laft Year in Bifcay and now at Cadiz are the chief, which are firting out to carry the Quickfilver to the WeftIndies this Year.
