HE Great Duke continues very well, and gave Audience Yesterday to the two Princes of Saxe Gotha, who have been here some time and are now on their Departure. The Duke, of Guastalla came on the 22d to make a Visit to his Sister the Prin-cess Eleanora at Campi, a Villa of her's about five Miles from hence.

Madrid, Aug. 26, N S. The Count de Taboada, Major General in his Catholick Majefty's Army, having been appointed Governour of the Groyne, and to command the Troops in Galicia, fet out for that Province the 20th In-ftant. The Count de Montemar Lieutenant-General h s been ordered to repair from Ca-talonia (whither he was fent lately to fupply the Room of the Marquess de Risbourg during an Indifpolition of which he is now recovered) to St Andero, to command the Troops which are in the Province and upon the Coaft of Bifcay. A Marriage is in Treaty between Don Francisco Casado, the Marquels de Monteleon's youngeft Son, and the eldeft Daughter of the late Marquefs de Campo Florido, who made a confiderable Fortune by taking to farm feveral Revenues of the Crown, and at his Death was President of the Council of the Finances. Letters from Cadiz of the zoth Inftant relate, that the Spanish Man of War Conquistador was returned thither from Malaga, and that the St. Joseph was also expected on her Return from thence.
