Madrid, September 2, N. S.

THE Marquess de Grimaldo having intirely recovered his Health, went last Week to St. Ildefonso, where he has his Office, and dispatches again the Business under his Direction: He is to remain there during the whole Time of the Residence of the Court. The Pope's Nuncio went from hence to St. Ildefonso the 25th past, and came back on the 29th, having had two Audiences of their Catholick Majesties, in which he made Representations in the Name of the Pope against the Resolution taken by his Catholick Majesty upon the Remonstrance made to him by the Council of Castille, to suppress the Bull for reforming several Abuses practised among the Spanish Clergy; which Bull was introduced three Years since by Cardinal Belluga, who came on Purpose with it hither, and afterwards returned to Rome: It is apprehended the rejecting of the said Bull may cause some Dissention between this Court and that of Rome. On the 27th past Count Konigsegg the Emperour's Ambassadour, dispatched one of his Secretaries Post to Vienna from St. Ildefonso. The Count de Roydeville Major General and Governour of Alicant, has been ordered by his Catholick Majesty to repair forthwith to Biscay, to take on him the Command of a Body of Troops upon that Coast, under the Direction of Count Montemar. Letters from Barcelona of the 24th past relate, that six Re-

giments of Foot are marching from Catalonia to Navarre, to reinforce the Troops on that Frontier. Letters from Cadiz of the 27th past relate, that two Frigates of 36 Guns each, which sailed the 9th past from St. Andero, are safely arrived in that Bay; and that two Men of War of 60 Guns each were daily expected there from St. Andero.

Stockholm, Aug. 24, O. S. The 18th Instant the King of Sweden went to take the Diversion of Hunting in the Neighbourhood of the Dahlers; from whence his Majesty returned to Carlberg the 20th; and on the 22d the whole Court quitted that Seat, and came to reside for the rest of this Year at the Palace in this Town. The Diet being to commence To morrow Seven-night, the Nobility and Deputies begin to arrive here from all Parts of the Kingdom.

Hague, Sept. 20, N. S. The States of the Province of Holland now assembled here, having disposed of several Commissions that were vacant in the Troops of their Repartition, have now under Deliberation the settling Funds for maintaining the Augmentation of their Troops: And their Admiralties are come hither, to be consulted on the easiest and most equal Methods of collecting the new Duties on Goods imported or exported. M. Kalkoen who is appointed Ambassadour from this Republick to the Ottoman Porte, having taken his Leave of the States General some Days ago, is on his Departure from Amsterdam for Constantinople.
