HEreare at prefent leveral Veffels in Port, as well outward as homeward bound, and amongt others, a Dutck man of War, called the Uliffing, who as he faith $s$ is appointed to cruife in the Channel.
Falmouth Fcb. 7. The fifth inftant arrived here the Neptune from Virginia, together with the Globe from Burdeaux, both belonging to this place.

Barnftaplc, Feb. 10. Yefterday came in here the Loyalty from Virginia, and the Margaret from Lifbonner, and may with the firft opportunity proceed for the Dorones.

Port mouth, Feb. Ir. The Dutch Fleet of Merchant men shat fayled, together with four Dutch men of War from Cozes, on Monday laft towards Holland, are by the late contrary winds forced backagain;

Lisbonne, Fan. 19. The Queen feems at prefegt pretty well recovered of her late illnefs of the fmall Pox, to the great joy of this Court. We are told of $2 n$ Envoy that the Prince Regent is fending to the States General of the United Provinces. The 'Prince hath, as is faid, refolved, that for the future any thip of above 24 Guns, of what Nation foever, thall have liberty to go to Bra\{ile; and geturn when they pleafe, without any Licence, oneJy giving fecurity, that they wiil return to fome part of this Kingdom, and there duly pay the ufual Cuftoms.

Warfaws, Fan. 22. From Trof cinianica in Podohit, we have advice, of the fixth inftant, that $D_{0-}$ rofensko having received confiderables alfiftance from the Tartars, refolved, his firf attemgt fhould he upon that place, which hethought, no way in a condition to refilt his power, they having in GarriIon but eight Companies of $P$ oles, confilting eacb of 50 Men , and three Troops of Horfe, which he accordingly put in execution: for on Chriftoms, Eve te formed the place with all his Forces, but was received fo bravely, that he was foon forced to fall off again ; the 26 he made an other affauls, though with no better fuccefs, then he had done the former; and the 29 it third, in which they preffed the Poles fo veheme rily ghat they werk forced to quit their Pofts, and retire to an inward CaAde, nut hazying rime tourakrexithertheir Brovifions or Anamunition

Turks this Spring, begin very much to allarme us, fo that it is not doubted, but the firft refolutions of this Dyet, will be for the fecuring the Peace of this Kingdom, Our Ambaffadors complain extreamiy of the bad entertainment they receive at Moskow, and from thence argue, the little affection that Government has for this Crown.

Alicant, fanuary 27. From Argiers of the 10 paft, wehave advice, that on- the 28 of Onober laft, the Flying Greybound an Englih Merchant man, FobnSilver Commander; of 200 Tuns and 18 Guns, was in her voyage homeward attacked a about twenty Leagues from the Southward Capic, by two Algerines, one of them mounted with 36 Guns, and the other with 28, with whom the faid. Captain maintained a long and brave Fight, till having by an unfortunate fhot, loft one of his Arms; and afterwards received many morral wounds, three of his Men killed, and nine wounded, his Ship was at length taken by the Turks, after it feemed almoft impofible longer to defend her, the being fas difabled and torn, that fhe had already fix foot waz ter in the Hould, and was no fooner in the polferf. on of the Turks, but immediately funk before the Turkshad taken any thing out of her; the Englifib Seamen happily faved themfelves, and were çarried to Argiers, where they now remain, the Captain dying four days after of his wourds, notwithftanm ding all the care of the Algier Captains to preferve his life.

Vienna, fanuary 30. The Turkih Chiaus having defired Audience of the Emperor, butnot obrained it, in relpeat he had not any Letters to his Imperial Majefty from the Grand Signior : hath firce contented himfelf ta exhibite his Cam: miffion to the Count de Montecuculi, Preßdent of the Councel of War; no anfwer hath as yat been returned him concerning his Propofals, of the Emperors not alfifing the Crown of Poland, granting paffage to the Grand Siguiors Forces, ${ }^{\circ} \mathrm{c}$. and as is thought, will onely be in general, That his Imperial Majefty will punctually obferve in all things, the Treaties at prefent on foot betwen the two Empires. The Spanifh Ambalfador goes on apace with the Leavies he is making for the Cervice of the Spanifh Neatherlands.
