#### A PROCLAMATION.

Requiring Quarentine to be performed by all Ships and Veffels coming from the Levant, the Isles of the Archipelago, Zant, Corfu, Veniza, Cephalonia, St. Mauro, or any of the adjacent Islands, or any of the Ports or Places of the Morea, into Great Britain, or the Isles of Guernsey, Jersey, Alderney, Sark or Man.

#### GEORGE R.

W HEREAS we have received Information W that the Plague, with which the Islands of Zant and Corfu have for fome Time past been visited, doth not only continue there, but has fpread itself to Veniza, Cephalonia, St. Mauro, and the Ports of the Morea, and that the Plague rages likewife at Smyrna; and whereas divers Goods apt to retain Infection are usually brought from the faid Islands and Places, and other Parts of the Levant; and it is of the utmost Importance to prevent the Contagion being brought into our Dominions by Goods or Perfons coming from any of the Places fo-infected ; We, out of our great Care for the Prefervation of our People, and to prevent the Infection being brought by Ships or Veffels coming into the Ports of this Kingdom, or of the Illes of Guernsey, Jersey, Alderney, Sark and Man, from any of the faid Places, by our Order in Council made this Fourth Day of July, have directed and required that all Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Perfons, Goods, and Merchandizes whatfoever, coming or imported in fuch Ships or Veffels, in or into any Port or Place within Great Britain, from and after the faid Fourth Day of this Instant July, from the Levant, and especially from Smyrna, or from any of the Ifles of the Archipelago, or from Zant, Corfu, Veniza, Cephalonia, St. Mauro, or any of the ad-

jacent Illands, or any of the Ports or Places of the Morea ; and allo all Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Perfons, Goods, and Merchandizes coming or imported in fuch Ships or Veffels, in or into any Port or Place within any of the Illes of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark and Man, from and after the Eighth Day of this Inftant July, from the Levant, or any other of the Places or Ports above-mentioned to be infected with the Plague, fhall perform their Quarentine in fuch Manner and in fuch Places as in and by the faid Order are directed. Now to the Intent that no Perfon may pretend Ignorance of our Commands therein, we have thought fit, by and with the Advice of our Privy Council, to give Notice, and do by this our Royal Proclamation, in purfuance of an Act made in the firft Year of our Reign, Entituled, An Act to oblige Ships coming from Places infected, more effectually to perform their Quarentine, and for the better preventing the Plague being brought from foreign, Parts into Great Britsin or Ireland, or the Illes of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark or Man, and to hinder the foreading of Infection, give Notice of the faid Order, and require that all Perfons do yield exact Obedience to the fame, viz.

1. That all Ships, Veffels, Perfons, Goods and Merchandizes from and after the faid Fourth Day of this Inftent July, arriving in any Port in this Kingdom from the Levant, and elpecially from Smyrna, or from any of the Ifles of the Archipelago, or from Zant, Corfu, Veniza, Cephalonia, St. Mauro, or any of the adjacent Iflands, or any of the Ports or Places of the Morea, do perform their Quarentine for Forty Days, which fhall be reckonship or Veffel fhall come to Anchor, or fuch Perfons Goods or Merchandizes fhall arrive at, or be put into the Place appointed for performing fuch Quarentine, and not before.
