Gratz, August 21, N.S.

N the 16th Instant the Lord Waldegrave gave a magnificent Entertainment to Prince Eugene, Count Schonborn the Vice-Chancellour of the Empire, the Princes of Saxe Uberhaufen, Leichtenstein, and several other Persons of Distinction of both Sexes. His Imperial Majesty began his Progress for Trieste between Five and Six the fame Afternoon, and propofes to be absent from hence about fix Weeks. His Imperial Majesty makes easy Journeys, and diverts himself with Shooting as he goes along, having killed 22 Stags the Day after he fet out from hence : In his Way he is likewife to receive the Homage of the States of Carinthia, Carniola, and Goritia. Prince Eugene is gone for a few Days to Count Lingenheims, to take the Diversion of Hunting, and propoles to make feveral little Ex-Emperour's Ablence, but Gratz is to be his chief Place of Refidence. Count Tarouca, curfions in the Neighbourhood during the the Portuguese Amballadour, having received the King his Master's Orders to attend the Court, arrived here on the 13th Inftant, and had an Audience of the Emperour the Day following.

Fontainebleau, Sept. 3, N.S. On Tuefday the 31ft of August, N.S. Count Massiei, the Sardinian Ambassadour, received an Express with Advice, that the Queen of Sardinia died suddenly at Turin on the 26th in the Morning, upon which he immediately dispatched another Express to give the same Advice to this Court. M. de Massiei is expected here himself next Week, to notify the Death of that Queen in Form, and it is supposed that on the 12th the Court will go into the deepest Mourning upon this Occasion.

M. Galvao, Envoy Extraordinary from the King of Portugal, having received a Letter from the King his Mafter to His Majefty, notifying the Death of the Infante of Portugal Don Alexander, who died of the Small Pox the 2d Inftant, N.S. in the 5th Year of his Age, prefented the fame to His Majefty at Hampton-Court on Sunday laft at a private Audience, to which he was introduced by his Grace the Duke of Newcaftle one of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State.

He had afterwards a private Audience of Her Majefty upon the fame Occafion, to which he was introduced by the Right Honourable the Earl of Grantham Her Majefty's Lord Chamberlain.

The Marques d'Aix, Envoy Extraordinary from the King of Sardinia, having received from the King his Mafter Letters for their Majefties, notifying the Death of the Queen of Sardinia, who died at Turin the 26th Inftant, N.S. after a few Hours Illnes, attended their Majefties at Hampton-Court on Thurfday laft, in order to deliver the fame, for which Purpose he had a private Audience of His Majefty, being introduced by his Grace the Duke of Newcastle one of His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State; and likewile a private Audience of Her Majefty, to whom he was introduced by the Right Honourable the Earl of Grantham Lord Chamberlain to Her Majefty.
