**O**N the 7th Instant Fifty Thousand Livres were carried to the Royal Treasury, for the Monthly Disbursement of the Annuities upon the Town-House, in Consequence of a late Ordinance published for that Purpose, and for erecting Monthly Lotteries. The Farmers General have procured the King's Order for seizing M. Goffelin, Receiver of the Salt Chamber at Dieppe. M. de Valcroissant, Major of the Queen's Regiment of Foot, is made Lieutenant-Colonel, in the Room of M. d'Affigny, deceased. A Boat coming hither from Rouen, richly laden with Sugar and other Merchandizes, was lost lately at the Pont de l'Arche; as have likewise two Dutch Vessels, the one going out and the other coming into the River of Nantz, with rich Effects on board belonging to the Merchants of that Place, who it is said have suffered extremely this last Year by the Loss of five Vessels belonging to that Town. The Duke of Pequigny's Marriage with Mademoiselle Courcillon, is to be celebrated the 17th Instant. M. Grimaldi, Envoy Extraordinary from the Republick of Genoa, is returned hither from London.
