N the 1st Instant, at Eleven in the Morning, His Britannick Majesty passed through Utrecht: Having been met near that Town by the Prince of Nassau Friseland, who step'd out of his Coach as soon as he was in Sight of His Majesty; who did the same, and having embraced his Highness, discoursed with him, while fresh Horses were put to his Majesty's Coach, after which the King proceeded on his Journey for Hanover. The Lord Townshend arrived here the 31st past at Night, and lodged in the Earl of Chestersield's House; who the next Day entertained his Lordship, all the Foreign Ministers, and other Persons of Quality, magnificently at Dinner, at two very large Tables. His Lordship and the Earl of Chestersield have had several Conserences with the chief Persons of this Republick, and this Morning his Lordship set out in Order to join His Majesty with all possible Expedition. The Lord Torrington went this Morning from hence for Amsterdam, where his Lordship will stay one Day, and then return to Helvoetsluys to sail back to England with the Yachts, and some Ships of War, having already sent the largest ships back to their Ports. The Squadron of this Republick, which was sitting out to sail to the Baltick, is countermanded.
