R E A T Preparations are making for the Reception of the Queen at Paris in the Beginning of November. After having vilited the Churches of Notre Dame and St. Genevieve, her Majefty will dine and fee a Ball at the Town-Houle, and at her leaving the Town there will be a fine Firework played off upon the River between the new Bridge and the Bridge Royal. The Marchionefs de Peze is dead in Childbed. It is faid the Marquefs d'Alincourt, Second Son to the Duke de Villeroy, will be made Duke and Peer of France. The Office of Infpector of the Cavalry, vacant by the Death of M. de Bouteville, is given to M. de St. Andre Iá Baftie Governour of Die. On the 24th Inftant the Fathers of the Oratory opened their General Chapter, where M. Herault the Lisutenant General de Police affifted as Commiffioner on the Part of the King. The Ceffions made by the Duke de Mazarin of his Dutchies and Eftates, in Favour of his Son the Duke de Ia Maillaraye, have been confirmed.
