THIS Day the Deputies of the Province of Utrecht brought to the States General their Ratification of the Accession to the Treaty of Seville, and that of Groningen only being now wanting, which is expected in a few Days, their High Mightinesses will be able to conclude this Affair by the Middle of next Week. The Minister of Morocco, who lately came from England, having Credentials from the present Emperour, had this Morning his first Conference with the Deputies for foreign Affairs; to whom he declared that he had two Things to transact, viz. the Delivery of his Presents, and the Ransom of the Dutch Slaves; to which the Deputies answered, ~~that~~ they would make their Report to their High Mightinesses, who very probably might grant him the usual Allowance during his Negotiation.
