W Hereas by an Order made by His Majefty in Council of the 4th Day of July, in the Second Year of His Reign, and in the Year of our Lord 1728, His Majefty was pleafed, out of His great Care for the Pre-fervation of his People, and for preventing the Infection, which then raged in Turkey and other Parts of the Levant, being brought into His Majesty's Dominions, by Goods or Perfons coming from any of the Places fo infected, to direct and require, That all Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Perfons Goods and Merchandizes whatfoever coming or im-ported in fuch Ships or Veffels, in, or into one Port or Place within Great Britain from any Port or Place within Great Britain, from, and after the faid 4th Day of July, from the Levant and especially from Smyrna, or from any of the Isles of the Archipelago, or from Zant, Corfu, Veniza, Cephalonia, St. Mauro, or any of the adjacent Islands, or any of the Goods and Merchandizes coming, or import-ed in fuch Ships or Veilels, in, or into any Port or Place within any of the Isles of Guern-July, from the Levant, or any other of the Places or Ports above-mentioned to be infected with the Plague, fhould perform their Quarantine in such Manner, and in such Pla-ses, as in and by the faid Order were directed.

And whereas the Governor and Company of Merchants of England trading into the Levant Seas, have by their Petition to His Majesty, represented the great Disadvantage and Burthen they lie under by the Continuance of tine.

A T the Court at St. James's, the 2d Day where they have taken in their Ladings, but have permitted them to proceed to their Ports have permitted them to proceed to their Ports of Discharge, in the same Manner as was practiled before any Quarantine was required, that therefore His Majesty would be pleased to grant the like Indulgence to his trading Subjects, for all fuch Ships which shall arrive from any of the aforelaid Places, as shall be accompanied with clean Patents or Bills of Health. His Majesty this Day took the fame into His Royal Confideration, and being defirous to encourage and promote the Trade of His Subjects, and to remove all Obstructions thereto, fo far as may be confi-ftent with the Safety of His People, hath thought fit to order, and doth hereby order accordingly, That the Commissioners of His Majefty's Customs do direct the Officers of His Majefty's Cuftoms in the leveral Ports of this Kingdom, to ftop all Ships and Veflels liable to the Performance of Quarantine, which now are arrived, or hereafter shall arrive in any of the faid Ports, (that is to fay) all fuch Ships and Veffels as are now arrived, or hereafter shall arrive in the Port of London, at the Hope; and all luch Ships and Veffels as now are arrived or hereafter shall arrive in any of the Out-Ports where such Ports or Places of the Morea ; and alfo all Ships are ordered to perform their Quarantine, Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Perfons, at fome convenient Diffance from the Town, Goods and Merchandizes coming, or import-ed in fuch Ships or Veffels, in, or into any fpectively to demand of the Mafters or other Perfons having Charge of fuch Ships or Veffey, Jersey, Alderney, Sark and Man, from sels on board the fame, their Patents or Bills and after the 8th Day of the faid Month of of Health, and to transmit the fame to the of Health, and to transmit the same to the faid Commissioners, who are hereby required to examine strictly into the said Patents or Bills of Health; and in case they shall appear to be clean Patents, and to be figned and fealed by the proper Magistrate of the Place where they took in their Ladings, and that the Ships Company are entirely free from In-fection, that then such Ships and Vessels shall be exempt from the Performance of Quaran-And the faid Committioners shall fend fuch Quarantine, and humbly prayed, that in Regard the States of Holland have not for fome Time paft required a Quarantine to be performed by any Ships or Vellels coming in, their Orders, for permitting fuch Ships and Vellels to proceed to their refpective Places of Difcharge, without performing Quaran-time : But if upon Examination, fuch Bills of User States Coming in, the coming in the states of the first states of the states of to their Ports, from any of the faid Places, Health shall not prove fatisfactory to the faid which have brought with them clean Patents Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs, or or Bills of Health, from the respective Places the faid Commissioners shall not be fatisfied
