**T**HE Cardinals de Rohan and de Bissy are set out for Rome, to assist in the Election of a Pope, having received the usual Allowance of 50000 Livres each at their Departure. On Monday the 13th Instant his Excellency Mr. Poyntz gave an Entertainment to the English residing at Paris, on Occasion of the Birth-Day of the Queen of Great Britain.

Her Majesty's Birth-Day falling on Sunday the First Instant, the Celebration of it was deferr'd till the Day following, when the Great Guns were fired at the Barracks, and answered by Vollics from the Regiments on Duty which were drawn out upon Oxmantown-Green. At Noon there was a numerous and splendid Appearance of the Nobility and other Persons of Distinction at the Castle, to compliment his Excellency the Lord Lieutenant upon this Occasion, before whom a Song was performed. In the Evening there was a Play given by his Excellency for the Entertainment of the Ladies; after which there was a Ball at the Castle.
