COUNT Potofzky, the Nephew of the Primate of Poland, arrived here some Days ago. Her Majesty the Czarina returned from her Pilgrimage to Troitz at Iſmailoff the 8th Instant, in perfect Health.

Dresden, Aug. 12, N. S. On Thursday Evening last the Countess Ozelka was married to a Prince of Holstein Beck; all the Foreign Ministers residing here were present at the Celebration of the Nuptials. The King's Journey to Warsaw stands fixed for the 16th Instant.

Stefwick, Aug. 13. His Danish Majesty has been a little indisposed for these few Days past, but is at present better; and 'tis hoped that his Indisposition will go off. General Lowenhorn, his Danish Majesty's Minister at the Court of Prussia, arrived here the 11th Instant from Berlin.

Whereas two Letters, one ſubſcribed Jon. H. and Tho. J. dated the 5th Inſtant, and the other ſubſcribed Jon. Reſolute, dated the 7th, have been received, by the Penny-Post, by Nathaniel Gould, Eſq; one of the Directors of the Bank of England, directed to him at his Houſe in Croſby-Square in Biſhopſgate-ſtreet, requiring him to come alone to Conſtitution-Hill and leave Ten Guineas in a Purſe under three Bricks which he ſhould find together, within three Yards of the Corner of the Wall of her Grace the Dutcheſs of Buckingham's Garden, and threatening, in Caſe of Refuſal, or of endeavouring to betray the Perſon that ſhould come to ſee if

the Money were there, purſuant to their Demand, that he the ſaid Nathaniel Gould ſhould not long ſurvive. His Maſteſty, for the better diſcovering and bringing to Juſtice the Perſons concerned in ſending the ſaid Letters, or either of them, is pleaſed to promiſe His moſt gracious Pardon to any one of them, who ſhall diſcover his Accomplice or Accomplices, ſo as he or they may be apprehended and convicted thereof.

And as a further Encouragement to ſuch Diſcovery, the ſaid Nathaniel Gould does hereby promiſe, that whoever ſhall diſcover the Perſon or Perſons who ſent, or contrived or directed the ſending of the ſaid Letters, or either of them, ſo as he or they may be convicted thereof, ſhall, upon ſuch Conviction, receive as a Reward, the Sum of Fifty Pounds of him the ſaid Nathaniel Gould.
