THE 3d of this Month, the Festival of St. Francis, whose Name the Elector of Mentz bears, was celebrated at Court with much Magnificence. On that Occasion the Emperour made a Present to his Electoral Highness of a Cross set with Diamonds to a great Value, as did the Empress of a very valuable Buckle set with Jewels for his Hat. The Nobility and Foreign Ministers made a splendid Appearance that Day, in Compliment to the said Elector. Their Imperial Majesties and the Archdutchesses dined in publick with his Electoral Highness, and at Night there was a Consort at the Palace. To-day his Electoral Highness set out from hence on his Return to Neus in Silesia.

Dresden, Oct. 6, N. S. The States of the Electorate of Saxony are to separate To-morrow, having finished the Affairs that were laid before them in the Assembly, to the Satisfaction of the Court. The King's Departure for Poland is fixed for the 20th Instant, and his Polish Majesty's Journey for Leipfick is put off, up-

Cassel, Oct. 11, N. S. His Swedish Majesty's Departure for Sweden is fixed for the 28th Instant. We have Advices from Brunfwick, that at a Ball which the Duke gave on Friday the 5th Instant, the two eldest Princesses of Bevern had so overheated themselves with Dancing, that the next Morning the Small-Pox appeared upon them; that this unfortunate Accident will put a Stop to their Journey to Berlin, which was fixed for the Beginning of next Month.
