Hague, Dec. 7, N.S. This Day the States of the Province of Holland reaffembled here. It has been fettled, that Conmodore Schryver shall return home; and that the three Ships which are ufually fitted out at Amsterdam in the Beginning of the Year to ferve for Convoys to the Merchant Ships bound for the Ports of Spain and Portugal, shall be ordered to cruize till fuch of those Merchant Ships as pass up the Streights return, off Sallee; by which Time two Frigates that are fitting out will arrive there to take the fame Station and relieve them. Thefe Precautions are used, because the King of Morocco refuses to ratify the Treaty concluded here by Admiral Percz. The Prince of Orange defigns to fet out for Groninghen about the Middle of this Month. Count Golofkin has delivered to the States a Letter from the Czarina, notifying the Death of the Ruffian Princefs lately deceafed, and that Minister goes into Mourning for fix Weeks on this Occasion.
