Paris, April 2, N. S.

N the 31st past the Cardinal de Fleury being with the most Christian King in his Closet, his Majesty sent for the Garde des Seaux, and was pleased to join him in Commission with the Cardinal for the Execution of the Office of First Minister; and also to appoint him to be the Cardinal's Successor in that Office: And the Garde des Seaux has since received the Compliments of the Nobility, the foreign Ministers, and other Persons of Rank and Distinction upon his Promotion.

Hague, April 4, N. S. Prince Cantimir de Valachie, Minister from the Czarma to the King of Great Britain, arrived here on the 2d Instant, and set out this Asternoon to imbark at Rotterdam for London. Count Kinski is arrived here from Paris, on tais Way to Vienna. We have Advice here of the Death of the Duke of Saxe Gotha, and of the hereditary Prince of Baden Dourlach.
