ETTERS from Breflau fay, that the Duke of Lorrain was expected there, of at his Principality of Tefchen in Silefia, on the 19th Inftant. His Serene Highnefs is likewife expected here very fhortly. The Turkifh Aga fet out the 22d Inftant with a Guard of 50 Soldiers and an Officer, on his Return to Conftantinople : We do not yet hear of any Perfon's being named to fucceed him. It is not yet certain that his Imperial Majefty goes to Carlsbad this Year ; but if he does, it will be with as finall a Retinue as can be. There happened a Fire this Morning at the Houfe of the Countefs of Stahrenberg, (who is the Widow of the late Ambafladour at the Court of Great Britain) but by timely Affiftance it did no great Damage. We hear that an Officer of Rank is appointed to go to Berlin, to return the Compliments fent from thence hither by Count Schulemburg, upon the Marriage of the Prince Royal with a Princefs of Bevern.

Count Schulemburg, upon the Marriage of the Prince Royal with a Princefs of Bevern. *Berlin, April 1, N.S.* The King of Pruffia has lately publifhed an Edict in Pruffia, ordering a certain Sect of Anabaptiffs called Menonifts, to withdraw with their Families and Effects out of his Dominions within three Months. The Court of Bevern left Potzdam this Morning on their return Home. M. Wakholtz, a Lieutenant Colonel in the

Elector of Cologn's Service, has been taken up by Order of his Pruffian Majefty: He is under an Arreft at Potzdam, whither he came to defire the King of Pruffia (whofe Valfal he is, having fome Lands in Pomerania) to place one of his Sons in the Company of Cadets. The King granted his Requeft, but fignified to him, that as to himfelf he fhould remain a Prifoner, as a Reprifal for the ill Ufage which his Pruffian Majefty's Officers conftantly meet with in the Elector his Mafter's Dominions:
