HIS Morning the Body of King Victor Amadeus was carried from Montcallier to the Supergue, a Church two Miles from this City on the Top of a Hill, appropriated for the Burial of the Sovereigns of this Country. As the Proceision pailed under the Ramparts in their Way to this Church, the Guns of the Town and Citadel were fired. The Body was attended by the Great Chamberlain, the Great Master of the Horse, a Captain of the Horfe Guard, with a Lieutenant and 70 The Body had lain in State for four Men. His Sardinian Majefty is retired to the Venerie, and has received there the ufual Compliments of Condoleance on this Occafion, and will not return hither till about the 18th Inftant.

Vienna, Nov. 8. The Emperour is perfectly recovered of his late Cold, and frequently holds Gabinet Councils. To-morrow Evening the new Opera will be performed, which was to have been done on the Emperour's Name Day; but the great Firework is not to be played off till the 15th, being the Feftival of St. Leopold, when their Imperial Majefties will return to this City from the Monaftery of Neuberg, or the 19th Inflant, which is the Name-Day of the Emprefs. Yefterday a Privy Council was held at Court upon the Affairs of Bohemia. The Duke of Lorrain will ftay here till after the Celebration of the Emprefs's Name-Day.

Berlin, Nov. 15. General Borck, and General Count Levenwolde Minister from Russia, have been these two Days at Potzdam, where his Majesty has had two private Conferences with them. The King is expected here next Sunday. The Privy Councellor M. de Borck is gone to Dresden, with the Character of Envoy Extraordinary to the King of Poland.

Hague, Nov. 21, N. S. The Prince of Naffau Orange, who was expected here from Bruffels on Saturday next, arrived here unexpectedly the 19th in the Evening. After having been to vifit the Prefidents of the feweral Colleges of the State, he teceived their Compliments Yefterday and this Day upon his Arrival, as alfo thole of the Foreign Minifters and other Perfons of Diftinction. He will remain here till the Beginning of the enfuing Year, on Account of the Affairs which relate to the Diftribution of the Effects of the late King William. The Grand Penfionary is now in a pretty good State of Health, and it is hoped that he will be able to affair at the Affembly of the States of Holland on Wednefday next. The Com-

miffioners of the Admiralty are still here. The Directors of the East India Company are gone home, having given their Sentiments upon certain Affairs which concern their Trade. The Sieur Pallavicini, who was Secretary to M. Hop at Paris, is nominated to be Conful of Holland at Algiers.
