WHEREAS His Majesty has signified to us His Royal Pleasure, That the Parliament of this Kingdom, which now stands prorogued to Thursday the Twenty First Day of this Instant December, be further prorogued to Tuesday the Third Day of April next; We do therefore publish and declare, That the said Parliament be, and accordingly the said Parliament is hereby further prorogued to Tuesday the Third Day of April next: Whereof the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Commons in this present Parliament are to take Notice accordingly.

Petersbourg, Dec. 2, O.S. The 30th of last Month being St. Andrew's Day, her Majesty was dressed with the Mantle and Collar of the Order, and went to Church in the Morning, attended by the several Knights of the said Order; after which her Majesty dined with them in publick. All the Foreign Ministers and Persons of Distinction had the Honour to dine at another Table in the same Room. This Court received a Courier some Days ago from Constantinople, by which they were informed, that the Plague that had destroyed a great Number of People in that Capital, was very much abated.

Hambourg, Dec. 23, N.S. The Dutchess of Bevern arrived here this Morning, accompanied by the Princess her Daughter (contracted to the Prince Royal of Prussia,) Prince Anthony Ulrich her second Son, Mademoiselle Katch, the Princess's Governess, Major Heimburg, and M. Berner.

Hambourg, Dec. 26, N.S. Yesterday the Dutchess of Bevern received a Courier from Vienna, which she redispached this Morning; and To-morrow her Highness intends to go from hence to Arensboeck, a Country Seat belonging to the Dutchess Dowager of Holstein Ploen, and from thence to Wolfenbittel. It is said that her Highness is only come hither to accompany her Son Prince Anthony Ulrich, who (it is reported) is going to Petersbourg, with a View of marrying the Princess of Mecklenbourg: It is thought that he will have an Interview with Duke Charles Leopold of Mecklenbourg-Schwerin before he proceeds on his Journey to Petersbourg.

Berlin, Dec. 27, N.S. On Wednesday last the King of Prussia, being accompanied by the Prince Royal, came hither from Potsdam. Both his Majesty and his Royal Highness were magnificently entertained Yesterday at Dinner by Count Seckendorff; and General Ginkel is making Preparation to do the same on Monday next.
