HE King of Poland went to Leipzig Fair on Wednelday laft, attended only by Count Frile, M. Bruhl, and his Mafter of the Horfe ; it is faid his Majefty's chief Bulinefs is to buy, or make a Bargain with Horfe-Dealers, to deliver him 600 Horfes to remount entirely the Dragoons that were taken out of the Polifh Regiments to be his Guard at Warfaw, and which are commanded by Colonel Rockau. His Majefty is expected back to Morrow, or next Day at fartheft; he was a good deal out of Order with a Cold when he fet out, and had been feverifh the Day before, which made People uneafy at his going. If he returns well, his Stay here will be very fhort, intending to begin his Journey to Poland about a Week hence.

Drefden, Jan. 7, N. S. The King of Poland returned from Leipzig the 4th Infrant, and is fo well in Health, that the Night before laft he was prefent at a Play acted at the Princefs of Holftein's by People of Diftinction; and laft Night being the Beginning of the Carnaval, his Majefty was at the Mafquerade : He is now preparing with all hafte for his Journey to Warfaw, which remains fixed for the 10th. It is faid that his Majefty made an Agreement with a Horfe Dealer for the Delivery of 600 Horfes at Warfaw in the Month of May next, for remounting the Troops commanded by Colonel Rockau. Here it is politively faid, that a Marriage is agreed on between the fecond Son of the Duke of Bevern, and the Young Princefs of Mecklenbourg. Hague, Jan. 16, N. S. The States of Holland will feparate To-morrow in order to reaffemble next Tuefday. A Letter has been written by the Prince of Orange to the States General, and to the States of Holland: His Highnels has also fent them a Copy of that he wrote to the States of Zealand, protesting against their Proceedings concerning the Marquisate of Ter Veer and Flushing; and has likewise fent Copies of it to all the Provinces.
