**T**HE Deputies from the Province of Guelderland to the Assembly of the States General, who went to Arnheim last Week to consult the States of that Province assembled there, are returned hither with their Resolution upon the Neutrality in the Austrian Netherlands now in Negotiation between France and this Republick. The States of Holland being to assemble To-morrow, most of the Deputies are already come hither. Letters which arrived Yesterday from Conigsberg and from Berlin advise, that a Body of Muscovites had entred Poland the 10th Instant, marching in two Columns directly towards Grodno; but there is yet room to doubt of this, neither Count Goloffkin nor Count Sinzendorff having received any Account of it. Count Sinzendorff makes Instances to the States to send their Deputies to Antwerp, for settling the Tariff or Rates on Goods imported into or exported out of the Austrian Netherlands.
