And we are also graciously pleased to declare, that Conduct Money, according to the Practice of the Navy, shall be allowed to all fuch Seamen and Landmen, fo voluntarily en-tring and rendring themfelves on Board, according to the true Meaning of this our Royal Pro-And for Prevention of any Deceits clamation. or Abules, which may happen by any Person or Persons leaving the Ships or Vessels to which they belong, and entring him or themselves on board any other of our faid Ships or Veffels, as aforefaid, in order to the obtaining the Bounty Money herein before granted; We do hereby likewife direct, declare, and command, that fuch Seamen and Landmen belonging to any of our Ships or Veffels of our faid Royal Navy, as shall abjent themselves from any of Navy, as fhall absent themselves from any of the faid Ships or Vellels, to which they shall belong, and fhall enter themfelves on Board any other of our faid Ships or Veffels, in order to the obtaining the faid Bounty Money, fhall not only lofe the Wages due to them in the Ship or Vefiel which they shall fo leave, but also be fe-verely punished according to their Demerits. verely punified according to their Demerits. And we do hereby further declare, that if fuch Men in our-Service, who are or fhall be per-imitted to be abfent by fuch Tickets as aforefaid, do not repair on board their respective Ships or Veffels by the Time allowed by fach Tickets, they shall not only be liable to be impressed, but to fuffer fuch further Punishment, as by Law may be inflicted on them, for fuch their Neg-lect. And we do hereby alfo ftrictly charge and command all the Captains and Officers of our Ships, and others, who shall be employed in the impressing of Men for our Fleet, that they take particular Care not to impress or entertain any Perfons whatfoever, who shall not be fitly qualified to ferve in our Royal Navy.
