ETTERS from Potzdam advile, that his Pruffian Majesty continues dangeroully ill.

Paris, Oct. 16, N. S. By Letters from the Army of the Allies in Italy, dated the ath of this Month, we have an Account, that on the 27th past they lest the Camp at Guastalla, and marched to Dozolo, where they lay till the 3d Instant, and then moved to the Camp of Commessagio, where these Letters less them. Part of the Right of the Army was extended along the Oglio to its Outlet, and the King of Sardinia had his Quarters at Sabionetto. Count Konigfegg having passed the Po with his whole Army the 20th of September, posted them facing that River, but on the 20th he changed his Ground, and extended his Right towards Montanara, and posted his Lest at Borgosorte, where he fixed his Head Quarters, and by this Situation the Army of the Imperialists have the Fossa Ma-estra before them. On the 30th, the King of Sardinia and the Marshal de Coigny de-tached the Marquels de Maillebois with six Squadrons and ten Battallions to form the Siege of Mirandola. The last Letters from the Army on the Rhine are of the 5th Instant, and import, that they continued encamped at Offenbourg, where they were in Barracks; but that Prince Eugene having fent away the greatest Part of his Troops to go into the Winter Quarters affigned them, and the Marshal d'Asseldt having received a Wound upon her Right Buttock, near a four in Length, and several inches deep; and another tends.

the King's Orders for putting his Troops also into Winter Quarters; was beginning to separate his Army. Prince Eugene set out on the 2d Instant for Vienna. The Troops he has left on the Frontier for the Winter are to be commanded by Prince Alexander of Wirtemberg, who will have his Head Quarters at Hailbron. The Duke of Aremberg is to command in the Black Forrest, and Count Seckendorff at Heydelberg, where some new Fortifications are ma-king. Prince Eugene had caused three Redoubts in the Isle of Neckerau, to be begun be-fore he left the Army, which Redoubts are to be furnished with Cannon; and left Orders for continuing the Lines which are to extend from the Hill above Heidelberg to Brill; which is a League and a half from Manheim.

Kensington, October 12.
