## Warfaw, October 5, N. S.

HE new Regimentary came hither two Days ago with a Guard of about 300 Men, 50 of which were Calmucks; he went away Yesterday to join 4000 Ruffian Troops, which he left Seven Miles off at a Place called Sochac-zow, and from thence will proceed with them in Purfuit of the Palatin of Lublin's Forces, which are march'd towards Sendomir. General Lacy continues still in Polish Prussia about Graudentz; Lieutenant Colonel Milcow is march'd with his Detachment of 200 Dragoons for Kalifch; from whence they are to be fent to their refpective Regiments that are posted thereabouts : His Expedition on the other Side of the River was unfuccelsful, having march'd feveral Miles and return'd without finding the Enemy ; how-ever fome Polifh Troops frequently come to Praag, and when any Detachment is fent over the Viftula, they immediately decamp and hide themfelves in the Woods that are near. Early this Morning the Saxons furprized a little Party of them, killed three, and took as many Priloners. The Marihal of the Confederation, M. Poninski, went the Day before Yesterday for Petrikow, to open the Tribunal, being not long ago made Staroffi of that Place; he is attended by 300 of the Crown Guards, who have Orders to conti-nue there during his Stay.
