FFAIRS fince the 12th Inftant have begun to take a pretty favourable Turn for King Auguftus; the Palatin of Kiovy, in Concert with the Grand Marfhal Munizcek, has very lately fent his Propositions, and demanded an Armiftice in his own Name, and in the Name of the Army; he has allo defired that Commillaries should be fent to a Place that shall be agreed upon, in order to their Capitulation : Whereupon King Augustus has appointed Major General Lewvendahl, and two or three Members of the Confederation for that Purpole, and they are to fet out very foon, waiting only the Arrival of General Lacy from Wengrow, to give his Directions for the Armistice. Here are politive Accounts from Lithuania, that the Districts or Territories of Ofmiana, Minsk, and Lida, have fent their Deputies to General Issue to defire to be exempted from Contributions. The 17th Inftant being the Anniversary of the Coronation of King Augustus, great Rejoycings were made upon that Occasion. The fame Day, unexpectedly to every Body, his Majesty confirmed Prince Czartorinski, Palatin of Ruffia, in his Poft of Commander in Chief of the Crown Guards.

Berlin, Jan, 22, N.S. Yesterday at Noon the King of Prussia came hither from Potzdam, and this Morning he appeared at the Parade on Horseback. Prince Lichtenstein is expected here in a few Days from Vienna, being charged with a Commission from the Emperor to his Prussian Majesty.

Berlin, Jan. 25, N. S. Colonel Ponikau, the Saxon Minister, has received a Letter from M. Bruhl, acquainting him, that the Crown Army, under the Palatin of Kiovy, had made Offers of submitting themselves to King Augustus. Yesterday being the Prince Royal's Birth-day, his Royal Highness gave a great Entertainment on that Occasion, at which their Prussian Majesties affisted.
