AT the Court at *Kensington*, the 13th Day of *October*, 1735.

P R E S E N T,

The Queen's most Excellent Majesty, Guardian of the Kingdom of Great Britain, and His Majesty's Lieutenant within the same, in Council.

Her Majesty in Council was this Day pleased to order, That the Parliament which stands prorogued to Tuesday the 14th of this Instant, should be further prorogued to Tuesday the 11th Day of November next.

Hanover, *October* 19, N. S. The King proposing, in Case he receives Advice of the Yachts being arrived at *Helvoetsluys*, to depart from hence for England on the 29th Instant, the Right Hon. the Lord *Harrington* has obtained his Majesty's Permission to set out for *Holland* on Sunday Morning next.

Kensington, *October* 11.

This being the Anniversary of their Majesties Coronation, there was a numerous and splendid Appearance at Court of the Nobility, Foreign Ministers, and other Persons of Distinction. At Noon the Guns in *St. James's Park* and at the Tower were fired; and at Night there were Bonfires, Illuminations, Ringing of Bells, and all publick Demonstrations of Joy throughout London and *Westminster*.

Whitehall, *October* 13.

On Wednesday the 8th Instant, in the Afternoon; Sir *Charles Wager* sailed from *Greenwich*, and arrived at *Helvoetsluys* the 10th, with the following Ships, Sloops, and Yachts, viz. *Nottingham*, *Tilbury*, *Preston*, and *Princes Louisa* Men of War; *Terrible* and *Otter* Sloops; *Royal Carolina*, *William* and *Mary*, *Fubbs*, *Mary*, *Katherine*, and *Charlotte* Yachts.

Whitehall, Aug. 29, 1735.

Whereas some anonymous Letters were lately sent to Mr. *John Kerr*, in *Norris-street* in the *Hay-market*, requiring him to lay Ten Pounds in a certain Place, and at the Time therein mentioned, and threatening, in case of Noncompliance, to burn his House, and to kill the first Person who should come out of his said House: And whereas on Tuesday last, the 26th Instant, in the Night-time, the House of Mr. *Nicholas Read*, *Haber-dasher*, at the Corner of the same Street, in the *Hay-market*, was attempted to be burnt, by putting Rags and Paper under the Door, and setting them on Fire by a Train of Gunpowder, which burnt Part of the Floor and Shop Door: Her Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Person or Persons concerned in the said Crimes, is pleased to promise her most gracious Pardon to any one of them, who shall discover his or her Accomplice or Accomplices in either of the said Crimes, so as they, or any of them, may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
