To the Intent that no Perfon may, through Ignorance of the Law, incur the Punithment enacted by the Act of Parliament herein after fet forth, it is thought proper to infert the fame at large in this Gazette.

Anno Nono Georgii II. Regis.

An Act to prevent the Lifting his Majesty's Subjects to scrve as Soldiers without his Majesty's Licence.

For the safety and Welfare of this Majefty's Subjects have been of late feduced to enlift themfelves to ferve as Soldiers under foreign Princes, States, or Potentates, which Practice is highly prejudicial to the Safety and Welfare of this Kingdom; for Remedy thereof, be it enacted by the King's most excellent Majefty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That if any Subject of the Crown of Great Britain, from and after the Twenty Fourth Day of June next, fhall,

land, or from and after the 29th Day of September next, without the fame, enlift or enter himfelf, or if any Perfon fhall procure any Subject of his Majefty, his Heirs, or Sucsef-fors, to enlift or enter himfelf, or hire or retain any Perlon being a Subject of his Majefty, his Heirs, or Succeffors, with an Intent to caufe fuch Perlon to enlift or enter himfelf, or procure any Perfon being a Subject of his Majefty, his Heirs, or Succeffors, to go beyond the Seas, or embark with an Intent, and in order to be enlifted to ferve any foreign Prince, State, or Potentate, as a Soldier, without Leave or Licence of his Majefty, his Heirs, or Succeffors, first had and obtained, for enlisting any of the Subjects of his Majefty, his Heirs, or Succeffors, to ferve any fuch foreign Prince, State, or Potentate, as Soldiers, under the Sign Manual of his Majefty, his Heirs or Succef-fors, every fuch Perfon fo offending, being thereof laxfully convicted, fhall be taken, deemed, and adjudged to be guilty of Felo-. ny, and thall fuffer Death as in Cafes of Felo-" ny, without Benefit of Clergy.
