Copenhagen, October 9, N. S.

THE King of Denmark still continues at Friedensburg, where his Majesty gives Audience to the Foreign Ministers weekly, on Fridays, and does not intend to remove into this Neighbourhood before the 28th *N. S.* when the Lutheran Jubilee is to be celebrated. Count Altemberg is expected here soon, having taken a House with a Design of passing the Winter in this City.

Gobrdé, Oct. 13, N. S. The King has been pleased to declare his Intention of leaving this Place on Friday the 19th Instant, for which Purpose the necessary Dispositions are making. His Majesty proposes to lye the first Night after his setting out at Celle, and to proceed the next Morning to Herrenhausen.

Hague, Oct. 16, N. S. The States of Holland separated on Saturday last, on account of the Indisposition of the Grand Pensionary, which still continues. Her Royal Highness the Princess of Orange is in perfect Health, and goes out every

Day to take the Air. M. Gravenbroek, the Palatine Minister, is returned hither from Amsterdam, whither he went some Days ago, and is preparing to set out to Morrow or the Day following for Paris by the Way of Manheim.
