We do therefore publish and declare, That the said Parliament be, and accordingly the said Parliament is, hereby further prorogued to Tuesday the Nineteenth Day of April next: Whereof the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Commons in this present Parliament are to take Notice accordingly.

Hague, Dec. 25, N. S. His Britannick Majesty arrived at Helvoetfluys, in good Health, on Friday last the 21st Instant, at Eight a-Clock at Night. His Majesty is detained there by contrary Winds. In the mean while his Majesty sends every Day hither to know how the Princess of Orange does: Her Royal Highness continues in a very fair Way. The Child of which she was delivered, was carried on Saturday last to Delft, and deposited in the Vault belonging to the Princes of Orange.

And as a farther Encouragement, her Majesty is also pleased to promise a Reward of Fifty Pounds for every one of the Criminals who shall be discovered and apprehended as aforesaid; to be paid upon the Conviction of the Offender or Offenders.
