Hereas Her Majesty hath signisied to us Her Royal Pleasure, That the Parliament of this Kingdom, which now stands prorogued to Tuesday the Twenty First Day of this Instant December, be further prorogued to Tuesday the Nineteenth Day of April next. We do therefore publish and declare, That the said Parliament be, and accordingly the faid Parliament is, hereby further prorogued to Tuefday the Nineteenth Day of April next: Whereof the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Commons in this present Parliament are to take Notice accordingly.

The Child of which she was delivered, was carried on Saturday last to Delft, and depolited in the Vault belonging to the Princes of Orange.

And as a farther Encouragement, her Majesty is also pleased to promise a Reward of Fifty Pounds for every one of the Criminals who shall be discovered and apprehended as aforesaid, to be paid upon the Conviction of the Of-fender or Offenders.
